Brief Introduction of UN Environment-Tongji Institute of Environment for Sustainable Development

UN Environment-Tongji Institute of Environment for Sustainable Development, hereinafter referred to as “IESD”, jointly established by UN Environment and Tongji University in 2002, has served as a strategic think-tank for UN Environment, an inter-disciplinary platform for Tongji University and contributed significantly to environment and sustainable development from three main pillars – education, research and outreach. IESD has the mandate to mainstream environment and sustainable development into higher education, to promote research, education and South-South Cooperation on the environment and sustainability, to enhance the service of science and technology to policy-making and implementation, and to provide tailored solutions to the Southern countries.

Up to date, IESD has provided environmental education for students from nearly 83 countries, and carried out capacity-building for more than 5,000+ participants from developing countries through training programs, seminars and forums. Meanwhile, in cooperation with UNEP, China’s ministries and diversified stakeholders, IESD undertakes research projects, including UN Environment-China-Africa Cooperation Program on Environment supported by Ministry of Science and Technology (MoST), Chongming Eco-Island Project, Green Economy Textbook, Multi-dimensional evaluation system on China’s low-carbon economy, South-South Cooperation Case Studies, etc. Till now, more than 100 patents have been applied in the environmental fields in China.

Furthermore, in collaboration with China Meteorological Administration (CMA) and Science and Technology Commission of Shanghai Municipality (STCSM), IESD has respectively established a Key Laboratory of Cities’ Mitigation and Adaptation to Climate Change (CMACCS) and a Key Laboratory of Chemicals Risk Management. Besides, IESD has been selected as the Secretariat for Global Universities Partnership on Environment and Sustainability (GUPES) with more than 560 members all over the world. Meanwhile, IESD and UN Environment have signed an MoU on the translation and publication of Chinese versions of UNEP important publications to mainstream the concept of environment and sustainability in China.

State Key Laboratory of Pollution Control and Resource Reuse

With its base on Tongji University and Nanjing University, the State Key Laboratory of Pollution Control and Resource Reuse boasts 3 national key disciplines including Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science and Civil Engineering, and 7 Ph.D programs. Approved by the State Planning Commission in 1989 and official opened to the public in 1995 upon acceptance by the State, the Laboratory has consecutively passed the three national assessments. The Laboratory, covering an area of 9,600m², currently has a faculty of 96 employees, including 66 senior professors and 27 associated senior professors. Among the faculty of the Laboratory, there are 3 Academicians of Chinese Academy of Engineering (CAE), 5 “National Specially-Appointed Experts of Thousand Talents Program”, 4 “Specially-Appointed Professors from Changjiang Scholars Program”, 7 recipients of “National Outstanding Youth Foundation”, 1 Nominee for the “National Hundred, Thousand, Ten-Thousand Talents Program”, 2 “Leading Science & Technology Talents of Ten Thousand Talents Program” launched by Organization Department of the CPC Central Committee, 1 “Innovative Research Team for Major Fields” by Ministry of Science & Technology of China, 20 winners of “New/cross Century Excellent Talents Program” by Ministry of Education of China, 1 “Leading Talent” of Shanghai Municipality, and 2 “Outstanding Academic Leaders” of Shanghai Municipality.

Targeting the strategic demands of the country and the state-of-the-art science and technology, guided by the Guidelines of the National Program for Medium- and Long-Term Educational Reform and Development, the laboratory gives priority to the major environmental pollution issues of common concern arising from the rapid economic development and urbanization process. Based on the scientific approach integrating basic research with application, pollution control with resource recycling, science & technology with engineering practice, the laboratory has conducted extensive innovative and interdisciplinary application/basic research concerning mechanism and impact of environmental pollution, principles and technologies for pollution control and resource recycling, etc. During this process, the laboratory has developed a series of pollution control and resource recycling technologies with independent intellectual property rights in such fields as advanced treatment of municipal wastewater, management and reuse of industrial wastewater, treatment, disposal and recycling of MSW, environment restoration and watershed pollution control, etc. Nowadays, the laboratory has become a globally recognized environmental science and technology innovation platform, international cooperation and exchange center, as well as high-end talents training base.

Research Areas:

1) Environmental behavior and ecological impact of pollutants

The research efforts of the Laboratory are mainly concerned with the multimedia environmental and chemical behaviors of toxic and hazardous pollutants and their combined pollution, including the transformation of pollutants in the complex system with multi-environmental factors, the biological effect and mechanism of action of organic pollutants, identification of ecological risk, which provide technical basis for establishment of early warning systems.

2) Water pollution control principles and technologies:

The research efforts of the Laboratory are mainly concerned with phosphorus and nitrogen removal from municipal wastewater, the treatment and management of wastewater generated from industrial park, pollution control and resource recycling of toxic substances, sludge treatment and resource recycling, principles and technologies for advanced treatment of drinking water, which provide technical support for water pollution control and management, as well as enhancing drinking water safety.

3) Solid waste disposal and resource recycling

The research efforts of the Laboratory are mainly concerned with bio-landfill and resource recycling of MSW (including biogas generation pattern in MSW landfill and emission control of greenhouse gases), and waste hydrothermal transformation principles and technologies (including hazardous waste disposal and MSW incineration technologies), which provide theoretical foundation and technical support for pollution control and recycling of solid waste

4) Environment restoration and watershed pollution control

The research efforts of the Laboratory are mainly concerned with principles and technologies for ecological restoration of water body, including research on urban water environment restoration and integrated management technologies, soil pollution restoration technologies, groundwater contamination restoration principles and technologies, long-term environmental management system for watershed pollution control, which provide support for comprehensive upgrade of water environment quality.

3) Each course is assessed through an examination with the grade being expressed as a percentage. The pass mark being 60.

4) If a master's candidate fails one course exam (or 2 courses) a makeup exam will be allowed. If the candidate passes the make-up exam, the credits will be acknowledged. If there are still more than one courses (including the first course) failed after the make-up

exam or more than 3 degree courses (including 3) failed, no more make-up exam will be given and it will be considered as quitting the school. If one fails any optional course exam, the candidate can repeat the course once again, but no credits will be recorded.

5) If a doctorate candidate fails a degree course exam, no make-up exam will be allowed if no special reasons can be provided.

C. Application Materials (HARD COPY SHOULD BE SENT/MAILED TO IESD OFFICE)

1. Application Form via <http://study-info.tongji.edu.cn> with the applicant's signature.
2. A photocopy of passport (pages with photo).
3. A photocopy of the degree certificate. If the certificate is not in Chinese or English, the original notarized translated versions must be submitted.
 - * The certificate should be notarized by local Chinese Embassy or local Chinese Consulates (or foreign embassies or consulates in China).
 - *Certificate of expected graduation issued by education in current academic institution (for applicants who will be graduating in the same year only).
 - *Degree certificate is required to be verified and notarized documents must be submitted at the registration.
4. Original or notarized academic transcripts (not a copy). If the academic transcripts are not in Chinese or English, the original notarized translated document must be submitted.
 - * The transcript should be notarized by local Chinese Embassy or local Chinese Consulates (or foreign embassies or consulates in China).
5. Recommendation letters from two professors or associate professors, in Chinese or English (signature and contact information are necessary).
6. Personal statement. Study and work experience, academic research achievement, planned research proposal should be included and individual development objective after graduation.
7. Catalogue and abstract of published papers, and other documents that can prove academic ability.
8. Letter of Approval from the professor of Tongji University if the applicant contact and assign a professor. Here's the link about the faculty in College of Environmental Science and Engineering to find potential mentor, which would also increase the possibility of getting the scholarship.

Admission and Registration

1. Please follow your application process in the Apply Online System. Once you have been successfully admitted to Tongji University, the admission status will change. The admission notice and visa documents (JW202 Form) will be sent off after two weeks of admission.
2. The admitted applicants should bring their Passport, Admission Notice, Visa Application Form (JW202) to the Embassy or Consulate of the People's Republic of China, and apply for a student visa. Students shall come to Tongji University for admission registration before the deadline indicated on the Admission Notice.
3. The first year for master-degree candidates and doctoral candidates is a trial year. Master-degree candidates and doctoral candidates are qualified to prepare a dissertation only after passing all the degree exams in the first academic year. Those who fail the degree exams will be considered as advanced-study students.

“Chinese Government Scholarship-Postgraduate Study Program” of Tongji University

I. Admission Requirements

- i. International students studying in China are not eligible, and
- ii. International students from joint-programs between China (Tongji University) and overseas organizations are not eligible, either.
- iii. Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals and in good health.
- iv. Applicants applying to study his/her native language or the language and literature of the third country such as English /French literature in China are not eligible.
- v. The applicants must fill out the forms offered and provide the following materials (in duplicate).

Those who are available for online application shall fill in and submit the application form online first at the following website (<http://laihua.csc.edu.cn>) The system requires you to put an agency code ; **The Agency Code of TONGJI is 10247** and then submit the printed version and the supporting documents as required by TONGJI University.

II. Application Requirements

i. Master candidates

- a) Bachelor's degree, and under the age of 35;
- b) Bachelor's Diploma (notarized photocopy), documents in languages other than Chinese or

- English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
- c) Original or notarized transcripts of all undergraduate courses, transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
 - d) A study or research plan (no less than 800 words) in Chinese or in English;
 - e) 2 letters of recommendation by two professors;
 - f) Photocopy of valid passport;
 - g) The catalogs and abstracts of published academic papers;
 - h) The Application Form for International Students wishing to Study at Tongji University (<http://study-info.tongji.edu.cn>);
 - i) 410rmb application fee.

ii. Doctoral candidates:

- a) Master's degree and under the age of 40;
- b) Master's Diploma (notarized photocopy), documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
- c) Original or notarized transcripts of all graduate courses, transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English;
- d) A study or research plan (no less than 1000 words) in Chinese or in English;
- e) 2 letters of recommendation by two professors;
- f) Photocopy of valid passport;
- g) The catalogs and abstracts of published academic papers;
- h) 1-2 academic dissertations, articles or outlines of dissertation
- i) The Application Form for International Students wishing to Study at Tongji University (<http://study-info.tongji.edu.cn>);
- j) 410rmb application fee.

* In addition to the above application materials, the university may require applicants to provide supplementary materials, depending on the circumstances. Application materials sent by email are unacceptable. Application documents will not be returned.

NOTES: The first academic year for both masters and doctoral candidates is a probation year. Candidates are qualified to prepare a dissertation only after passing all the degree exams in the first academic year and after passing the interim evaluation. Credits scored on probation will be included in the total credits. Those who fail the degree course exams will be considered as advanced scholars.

Remarks:

- * Applicants for architecture, urban planning, artistic design and industrial design are requested to submit one disk recording of their works (two sketches, two color paintings and two other works).
- * Application materials will not be returned regardless of the result of application. Documents such

as original diplomas must be kept at their own hand.

* If the courses for doctoral or master-degree candidates are conducted in Chinese language, they must provide HSK(Chinese language proficiency) certificate, at least Band III; Applicants without any Chinese language knowledge are compulsorily required to take it for 1 to 2 years; If the courses are conducted in English, the provision of HSK is not required.

Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship

In order to Recruit more and higher level international students to study the distinguishing feature of majors, to undertake the Educational Strategy of Shanghai, to build an excellent educational environment and to make Shanghai a bigger center for international students nationwide, Shanghai government has set a special fund, i.e. "Shanghai government scholarship for international students," as an action plan, which is conducted to accelerate the development of education in Shanghai for international students.

The following detailed rules formulated in accordance with the implementation of "Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship for International Students".

I. Scholarship Content

i. Category-A Scholarship: For excellent prospective students applying for master or doctoral degree programs;

a) Scholarship Standard: Waiver of fees of tuition, accommodation, serious disease and accidental Injury Insurance;

b) Monthly living allowance: Master-degree candidate: 3000RMB/M

Doctoral candidate: 3500RMB/M

ii. Category-B Scholarship: For excellent prospective students applying for master, or doctoral degree programs.

a) Scholarship Standard: Waiver of fees for tuition, serious disease and accidental Injury Insurance, expenses of basic study materials;

II. Eligibility

Category-A&B Scholarship

a) Applicants must be non-Chinese nationals in good health.

b) Education background and age limit:

- Applicants for doctoral degree studies must have master's degree and be under the age of 40;

- Applicants for master degree studies must have bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35;

- Applicants for undergraduate studies must have completed senior high school and be under the age of 25.

c) Outstanding in academic study and daily performance.

d) Not been awarded any other Chinese government scholarships at the time of application.

III. Application Materials

- i. Fill in and submit the application form online first at <http://study-info.tongji.edu.cn> and www.study-shanghai.org, and then submit the printed version with the following materials.
- ii. The Application Form (including application materials mentioned above) and registration fee (410RMB) must be arrived at the International Student Office of Tongji University before April 10th, each year.
- iii. Two copies of the Shanghai Government Foreign Student Scholarship Application Form.
- iv. Category-A&B Scholarship applicants should provide the following materials:
 - a) Original or notarized degree certificate. If the certificate is not in Chinese or English, the original notarized translated versions must be submitted.
* The certificate should be notarized by local Chinese Embassy or local Chinese Consulates (or foreign embassies or consulates in China).
Certificate of expected graduation issued by education in current academic institution (for applicants who will be graduating in the same year only). Degree certificate is required to be verified and notarized documents must be submitted at the registration.
 - b). Original or notarized academic transcripts. If the academic transcripts are not in Chinese or English, the original notarized translated document must be submitted.
* The transcript should be notarized by local Chinese Embassy or local Chinese Consulates (or foreign embassies or consulates in China).
 - c) Study plan in Chinese. Information such as basic personal information, education background, working experience, and interested research projects and research plan if were accepted as the doctoral student should be included. (Master: no less than 1000 words; Doctor: no less than 1500 words)
 - d) Published paper title, abstract and other certificates and material that can attest to academic achievement and research ability.
 - e) Applicants for Doctorate or Master Programs must provide two letters of recommendation in Chinese or English by professors or associate professors.
 - f) Complete materials should be sent to International Students Office of Tongji University, and "Application for Shanghai Government Scholarship" should be written on the envelop.

IV. Application Evaluation

i. Category-A&B Scholarship:

- a) Applicants should submit the complete application materials mentioned above to the TONG JI International Student Office before the deadline . The International Student Office will confirm the validity of the application material and assess the candidates' suitability, and then the qualified application package will be transferred to the related schools or colleges for further evaluation.
- b) The evaluation results will be reported back to the International Student Office on the fixed time.
- c) The Tongji International Student Office will confirm the final name list and post it on the

International Student Office homepage during soon. One week later, A notice of receipt of Scholarship will be sent to the recipients.

ii. Face to face interview may be requested if it is necessary.

V. Others

i. The University will submit the evaluation results including the name list and copies of the application material to the Shanghai Education Committee in one month after the annual review.

ii. Recipients of the scholarship should register at the university on time otherwise the scholarship will be withdrawn and the applicant will be considered to have automatically abandoned their studies.

iii. Scholarship recipient of A or B should participate in the Scholarship Annual assessment. International Student Office will perform a comprehensive review of scholarship recipient' academic records, learning attitude, performance, rewards or punishment received. Students who fail to meet the requirements will have their scholarship status suspended or cancelled.

MOFCOM Scholarship

MOFCOM Scholarship is set up by Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China to further strengthen the communication and cooperation between China and other countries as well as to develop talents for developing countries. Starting from 2015, MOFCOM Scholarship mainly sponsors the young and the middle-aged talents from recipient countries to pursue their postgraduate degree education in China and entrusts China Scholarship Council to administer the Scholarship.

The International Master Programme in Environment Management and Sustainable Development is now open for application. This master programme is sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China, and coordinated by the UN Environment-Tongji Institute of Environment for Sustainable Development.

The programme provides assistance to governmental officials, research fellows, and senior managerial personnel on their master and doctor education in China, which are fully conducted in English. Marine Scholarship of China

The Marine Scholarship of China for the year 2017 is now open for application, and the application deadline is April 10th, 2019 (with all the online procedures completed and documents sent to contact person of School of Ocean and Earth Science, Tongji University).

The Marine Scholarship of China is jointly initiated by the State Oceanic Administration (SOA) and the Ministry of Education of China (MOE) for the purpose of providing financial support to outstanding students from the coastal countries or regions around the South China Sea, the Pacific and the Indian Oceans and African developing countries to study in China for a master's or doctoral degree in oceanography or other related specialties.

I. Eligibility

1. The applicant should be a citizen of non-Chinese nationality in good health, from a coastal/island country of South China Sea, the Indian Ocean, the Pacific and its surround island countries, or an African developing country.
2. The applicant for master's degree studies is required to have a bachelor's degree of related fields and be usually under the age of 40.
3. The applicant for doctoral degree studies is required to have a master's degree of related fields and be usually under the age of 45.

Marine affairs related majors, including but not limited to:
